Meeting with Laurie Dalrymple

1. Away Support

Quinssa informed Laurie of the history re coaches and tickets when Quinssa ran the coaches and now Zeelo have taken over. The issues with both systems were explained. The current issues with Zeelo can be summarised as follows:

- They are not marketed early enough the coaches that will run for the rest of the season should be marketed now.
- There should be clarity of how many are needed to run the coach and when the decision will be made if the coach will not run.
- The coaches should be actively marketed by Quins as well as Quinssa.
- Tickets for away games are no longer available via the Quins ticket office we believe that this is an agreement with all premiership clubs for premiership games. Supporters would like to sit with other supporters is there any way that Quins can facilitate this?

Laurie agreed that things needed to change and he would investigate. Warren Kennedy is the Quinssa link for coaches.

2. Home Support

Quins have set up a working committee to create a memorable match day experience and especially to encourage younger supporters and existing supporters to attend all matches. Currently 30-40% of season ticket holders fail to attend matches. The average age of current supporters is 37.

There will be a big change at the Saracens game on 26th January.

Some of the changes mentioned were more music, more PA announcements, more flags, fireworks, Players at gates greeting supporters, more content on the screen, PA countdown building support, PA reminders to get supporters to their seats on time.

Quins would like feedback on how things are working. Quinssa will collect feedback from their members.

Laurie asked that we are respectful of any Saracens supporters that come next week and that we publish that to our members

3. Payment for subscriptions

Quinssa Membership payments collected by Quins have not been received. Laurie referred this to James Swanson.

4. Quinssa Events

5. Quinssa Merchandisee

Quinssa need to liaise with Adrian Wells to agree merchandise that Quinssa can sell.

6. New Stadium

Laurie informed the committee that discussions are still underway with the council and key stakeholders but that this is not a fast process. The owners are committed to the new stadium but focus is also on ensuring that we can fill a new stadium. As Laurie explained, 80,000 people attend the Big Game – Quins need to harness this.
